

Billie Bourgeois' Workshop Materials

We are using acrylic paints because of their fast drying factor and because we will do some collage. We will use a variety of mark making techniques.

PAINT...

Acrylic paints like Golden or Liquitex

(2 tubes each of reds, yellows, blues, 1 raw umber and 1 large titanium white)

Acrylic Matte medium fluid small bottle

Acrylic Matte gel medium, small jar

PALETTE...

white paper plates with sealed/slick surface

2-3 Gallon sized zip lock bag

Reynolds Kitchen Freezer Paper (Walmart)

Masterson covered palette is good but not required

BRUSHES & PALETTE KNIVES

Palette knives for mixing paint.

Brushes.....Variety of sizes and lengths

Old tooth brush

SURFACES:

Watercolor paper: Cold Press 140 lb. 5 sheets. 22"x30" (you may not need that many sheets but I like you to have some extra available.)

1 drawing board (can be very stiff cardboard or scrap plywood or whatever you have. 24"x36" ish just large enough to accommodate a full wc sheet which is 22"x30")

FOR MONOPRINTS....

1 8x10" sheet of clear plexiglass

1 WET erase marker, BLACK . I use Expo Vis-a-Vis. I order from Amazon. Or try Walmart or Office Depot. You can get a pack of colored ones for extra fun.

Misting spray bottle (small)

Paper towels

For STENCILING...

2 Manila folders (can be old or used) to cut stencils

Xacto knife

Small Cutting board or surface

Old toothbrushes

Other...

Rice paper or white basket style coffee filters Sharpie or other permanent marker (black)

Old credit card or hotel key (for scraping)

Drawing pencil

Sketchbook

Masking or painters tape

Scissors

Apron

Your cell phone and/or iPad camera will come in handy
